



Permitted Medication Rules

This document should be read in conjunction with **Rule 2.4 (j): Medication** in the HPA Blue Book.

Permitted Medications are as follows. For the avoidance of doubt, any medications not listed are **prohibited in competition**.

Permitted without restrictions:

Anthelmintics (wormers)

Permitted only when prescribed by a practicing and licenced MRCVS for a specific condition:

Antibiotics
Antifungals
Diuretics
Clenbuterol (e.g. Ventipulmin®)
Dembrexine (e.g. Sputolosin®)
Isoxuprine (e.g. Navilox®)
Altrenogest (e.g. Regumate®)
Cimetidine (e.g. Tagamet®)
Ranitidine (e.g. Zantac®)
Omeprazole (e.g. Gastrogard®)
Methocarbamol (e.g. Robaxin®)
Dantrolene (e.g. Dantrium®)

Permitted only when prescribed by a practicing and licenced MRCVS for a specific condition and not administered within 24 hours of competition:

Non-Steroidal Anti-inflammatory Drugs (NSAIDs) (e.g. Phenylbutazone/'bute')
Corticosteroids (e.g. Dexamethasone®)

All yards should keep medication records for all ponies, and this must be available for inspection if required.
